



NORTH AYRSHIRE OPEN ART EXHIBITION 2026

EXHIBITION RULES

Artists are invited to submit 2 original artworks for selection via an online application process. The application deadline is the 7th June.

Please bring your artwork to the 'Raquet Hall' at Eglinton Country Park, Kilwinning on Saturday the 27th June, between 10.30am and 3pm.

- The artwork must be the original work of the artist and the size for individual works is limited to 152cm x 152cm (5ft X 5ft).
- The maximum number of entries per applicant is two. There will be a charge of **£10 for one entry, £20 for two entries.**
- Entry fees should be paid in cash on Submission Day: **Saturday 27th June.**
- If you are submitting sculpture, please read the separate information sheet and follow the instructions for paying fees by bank transfer.
- Pictures must be framed suitably and securely. There must be D-rings attached, please see the 'Fixing Instructions' page for instructions.
- When you arrive on submissions day you must unwrap your artwork, pay your fee and we will attach a pre-made label to each artwork.
- Submitted artwork will be subject to a selection process. The selected work will be announced on our website www.northayrshireopenart.com on **2nd July.**
- Unselected work will remain in safe storage until collection day on **19th July.**
- The North Ayrshire Open Art Exhibition Committee will charge a **commission of 30% on all artwork sales**, this should be taken into account when pricing your work. **Due to insurance costs, we will not be accepting artwork priced above £1,000.**
- All artwork must be collected from the 'Raquet Hall' between **12pm and 3pm on Sunday 19th July.** No alternative date or time can be arranged.
- Unfortunately, we cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage to the artwork so it's important to arrange your own insurance.
